



Welcome to CresFest Camping 2026

We have two camping locations in 2026:

1/ Lingbogol Girl Guide Camp Site, Geddes Road, Creswick

Main Festival Campsite - for festival ticket holders, artists and volunteers

2/ Log Cabin Camp, 270 Ascot-Creswick Rd, Creswick

For festival ticket holders in campervans or caravans or for those who prefer cabin style accommodation.

Terms and Conditions

Please read below for information about and the Terms & Conditions for your camping experience. Please note that campers camp at their own risk and CresFest takes no responsibility for lost, damaged or stolen property.

Camping tickets / passes / wristbands / arrival instructions

- All camping passes must be purchased via the CresFest website or at The Festival Hub on arrival.
- Registration for all ticket-holders is at the Festival Hub in central Creswick (RSL building, Albert St). Campers will be issued with a campers wristband for each person, in addition to their festival wristband.

Arrival

- Those who have booked for Thursday arrival should arrive between 4.00 - 8.00pm.
- Those who have booked for Friday arrival should arrive between 2.00 - 8.00pm
- Those who have booked for Saturday arrival should arrive between 8.00am - 12.00 midday.

These are the times we have Volunteer Marshals on duty to show you where you are allowed to camp. If you arrive outside these times and have set up camp in a non-approved area - you will be asked to move!

- Tent & small campervan campers should register at the Festival Hub before going to the campsite.
- Campers who are sleeping in a large vehicle (eg caravan) may wish to set-up at their campsite prior to registration at the Festival Hub to avoid having to park the van in town. In this instance, upon arrival at your campsite, present your receipt for your camping to show to the marshals at the entry point. Upon completion of camp-site set-up, go to the Festival Hub to collect your wristband.
- No access will be provided to the campsite without proof of purchase or eligibility (receipt for camping purchase / artist accommodation email).

Festival Hub Opening Hours

- Friday 4 April 2025: 1.00pm - 9.30pm.
- Saturday 5 April 2025: 8.30am - 7.00pm
- Sunday 6 April 2025: 9am - 3.00pm
- If you arrive outside of these hours, please check in when the Hub re-opens.

Cancellations

Camp-site purchases are non-refundable, but they are privately transferable.

Pets

No pets are allowed in the camping grounds, no matter how well behaved they are.

Power & Water

All our camping sites are UNPOWERED. BYO solar panels if you require power.

There is no water hookup at any of our campsites.

There are taps available with drinking water.

Rubbish

Please take your rubbish away with you as we have limited waste management resources.

About Lingbogol Campsite

Lingbogol is a property run by Girl Guides Victoria, located in Geddes Street, off Broomfield Road, approx. 3.5 km north of Creswick township. The property will be available for camping for CresFest ticket holders, artists and volunteers. It is the festival's main campsite. Booking is only available via the CresFest website - DO NOT contact the Girl Guides directly.

General Information

- The camping area is operational from 4.00pm Thursday 9th April to 10am Monday 13th April 2026.
- Volunteers will be on-site on Friday 2pm - 8pm and Saturday 8am -12pm to marshal campers to appropriate camping areas upon arrival.
- Access is via a graded dirt road.
- There will be approx 70 vans and tents camping onsite at Lingbogol.
- All buildings on this site are NO SMOKING

Camping instructions

- Please follow the marshals' instructions about where and where not to camp. There are no marked sites, and we are quite full, so please be considerate when choosing your site.
- Camping under trees is considered dangerous and is forbidden.
- No fires or gas burners are permitted.

Cabin accommodation

- There are cabins located at Lingbogol but these will only be made available in cases of emergency. They cost more than a campsite and anybody who requires emergency cabin accommodation will be charged at the time before gaining access.

Kitchen facilities

- A kitchen area will be available for use. Please keep it clean & tidy. We request that you take your rubbish away with you. Wash all dishes that you use and put them away.
- Please do not remove dishes from the kitchen & eating area!
- There is a large internal community area available for dining, playing instruments or just sitting and chatting. There is also a large, sheltered, undercover, outdoor dining area with tables and chairs. Please keep these areas clean & tidy and be considerate of other users.

Toilets & Showers

- Campers will not have access to power or water hook-up at their site.
- A 4-toilet / 4-shower building is available between the kitchen and accommodation cabins.
- A rustic building with 2 working toilets is available in the camping area past the machinery sheds.
- Portable toilets and showers (including accessible facilities) will also be available in the camping area.

About Log Cabin Camp Campsite & Cabins

Log Cabin Camp is a privately owned children & youth group outdoor adventure facility. The owners Christine & Grant have been fabulous supporters of CresFest from its inception 5 years ago. They primarily offer cabin style accommodation, but this year have kindly provided additional space for a limited number of tent & van campers. Booking is only available via the CresFest website - Please DO NOT contact the Log Cabin Camp directly.

General Information

- The cabins & camping area are operational from 2.00pm Friday 9th April to 9am Monday 11th April 2025. Please note EARLY CHECKOUT on Monday - they have another group coming in!!
- Some volunteers & artists have been given permission to arrive Thursday afternoon as they have early commitments on Friday.
- Volunteers will be on-site on Friday 2pm - 8pm and Saturday 8am -12pm to marshal campers to appropriate camping areas and booked cabins upon arrival.
- All buildings on the site are NO SMOKING
- Some camping sites do have access to power but it is limited and you need to BYO long power lead. 1st come 1st served basis.

Camping instructions - please see attached (Rules)

- Please follow the marshals' instructions about where and where not to camp. There are no marked sites, and we are quite full, so please be considerate when choosing your site.
- Camping under trees is considered dangerous and is forbidden.
- No fires or gas burners are permitted.

Cabin accommodation

- There are a variety of cabins available. Some have ensuite bathrooms. Others are located close to a large, modern ablutions block with toilets and showers.
- All Cabins need to be booked in advance via our website or at the Festival Hub. Please DO NOT CONTACT the Log Cabin Camps directly.

Kitchen facilities

- A kitchen area will be available for use. Please keep it clean & tidy. We request that you take your rubbish away with you. Wash all dishes that you use and put them away.
- Please do not remove dishes from the kitchen & eating area!
- There is a large internal community area available for dining, playing instruments or just sitting and chatting. There is also a large, sheltered, outdoor dining area with tables and chairs. Please keep these areas clean & tidy and be considerate of other users.

Toilets & Showers

- Campers will not have access to water hook-up at their site.
- There is some access to power - BYO long power lead. Limited plugs available - 1st come 1st served basis.
- Campers will have access to the general ablutions block which has toilets and showers.
- Some cabins have their own en-suite bathrooms. Others will have use of the general ablutions block which has toilets and showers.

Shuttle Bus service

- The festival shuttle bus will run between Log Cabin Camp and the RACV via Creswick town centre, Lingbogl Girl Guide Camp, Creswick Woollen Mill and various festival venues, stopping at existing (V-Line) bus stops.
- The route and schedule are published in the printed Festival Program and will be available on the Festival Website and the Festival App (new for 2026). Start and finish times can also be found at the Hub.
- The stops will be clearly signposted.
- Please thank our hard-working volunteer bus drivers as they get us around the township!
